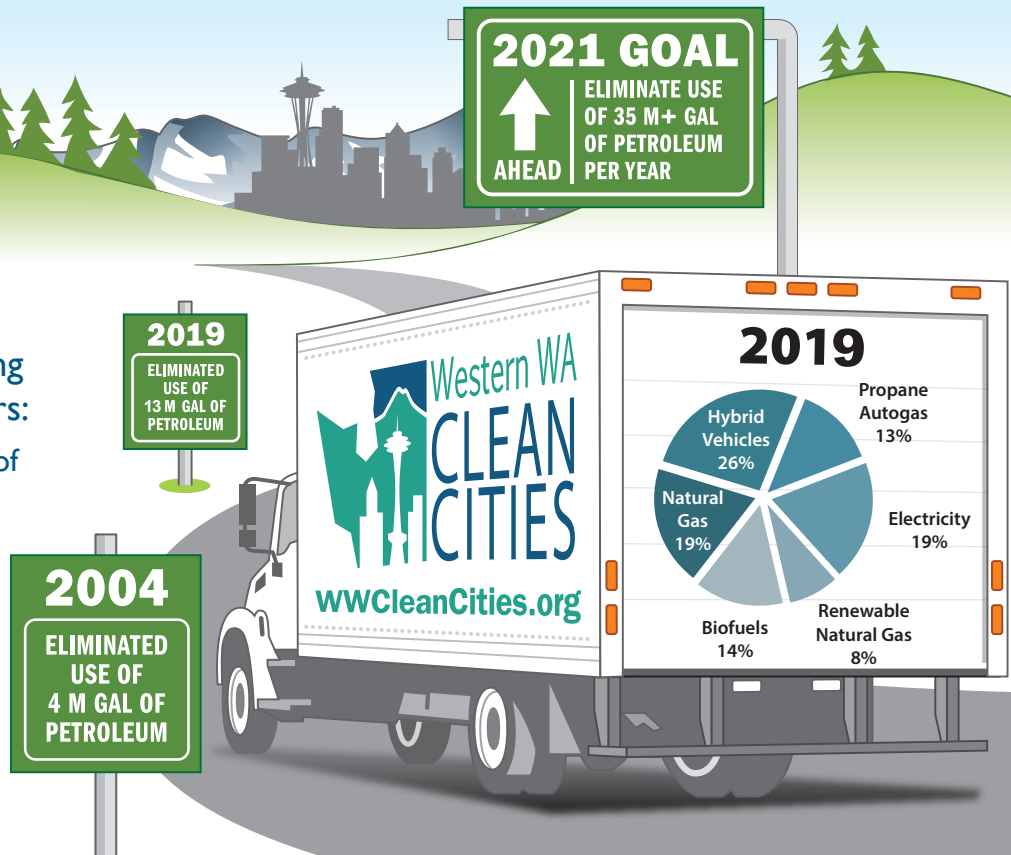
Our Coalition
